TOP 100 CELLAR SELECTIONS Anne Krebiehl

97 MURÉ Riesling 2016 Clos Saint Landelin Grand Cru Vorbourg

Lime, lemon, and bergamot zest tantalize on the nose with their shimmering nuances of green and yellow freshness. The palate adds a textured backdrop that has something of citrus pith, providing a layer against which this vivid zestiness can play out. There is a substance and depth and wonderful purity. The finish is dry and those flashes of aromatic citrus peel continue throughout. Wonderful. Drink now through 2035.

93 MURÉ Crémant d'Alsace Rosé

A pale-pink color and an appetizing aroma of baked red apples make this very appetizing. There is a certain creaminess on the nose, too, which also pervades the wonderfully tart but ripe red-apple fruit. In the background is a hint of patisserie as a proof of subtle autolysis. This is fresh with pristine flavors and tiny bubbles. It's a real joy.

93 MURÉ Crémant d'Alsace «Cuvée Prestige»

A wonderfully heightened note of lemon exists midst the apple richness on the nose. The palate comes across as very fine and super creamy with its multitude of tiny bursting bubble that swish across the palate with their freshness and flavor. Stony freshness resides somewhere deeply at the core of this wine. There is creaminess and red-apple briskness, gentle aroma and stony depth. The finish of this classy and elegant sparkler is dry and utterly moreish.
