TOP 100 VALUE WINES OF 2023 100 Tasting Notes

Our No. 1 value wine of 2023: the Muré Riesling Alsace Grand Cru Vorbourg Clos Saint Landelin 2019.

Riesling 2019 Clos Saint Landelin

Take our No. 1 wine, for instance. The Muré Riesling Alsace Grand Cru Vorbourg Clos Saint Landelin 2019 is a stunning Alsatian riesling with massive structure and power that can be found for around \$33. It's made from grapes grown biodynamically on a south-facing, terraced section of the grand cru vineyard Vorbourg, has amazing fruit concentration, a chalky minerality and a long, diamond-bright finish. It's probably the best dry white that Thomas and Veronique Muré have made, according to Senior Editor Stuart Pigott, and it also finished as the No. 7 wine on our Top 100 Wines of France 2023 list and No. 26 on our Top 100 World Wines list.
