96 MURÉ Pinot Gris 2016 Sélection de Grains Nobles Clos Saint Landelin

The 2016 Pinot Gris Clos Saint Landelin Selection de Grains Nobles exhibits a clear orange-golden color along with a perfectly spicy and noble bouquet of botrytized Pinot grapes, orange, mandarin and honey aromas intertwined with mineral and subtle oaky and crème brûlée notes. Bottled with 9% alcohol, this is a sweet, round, stimulatingly elegant and refreshing salty Pinot Gris that is not only perfectly balanced and elegant but also highly stimulating and food-friendly. Drink by itself or with desserts that are not too sweet. Tasted in April 2021.
