The top 100 Wines of 2022

93 MURÉ Pinot Gris Clos Saint Landelin 2018

Petrol and a bit of coriunder on the nose hint at something savory and interesting. It's dense and a little oily in texture, but linear on the palate, pulsating with notes of lemon zest and serious acidity. The finish is long and savory. This is a bold wine that can act as a beautiful counterpoint to fried foods.

92 MURÉ Sylvaner Steinstuck 2019

Fragrant grapefruit mixes with meadow grasses and just a hint of smoke for a really intriguing aroma. This wine is lively on the tongue, light-bodied and spritely grapefruit acidity bolstered by minerality. It's an elegant, savory wine that would make a nice aperitif alongside a cheese board.

91 MURÉ Pinot Blanc Les Iris 2020

Pineapple and fresh fennel scents are both fun and sophisticated. This wine is all business on the palate, though - restrained and light bodied, with lean, muscular notes of wet stone and lemon zest rippling just below the surface. The finish is long and suggests dried herbs and petrol; this austere wine may be a little bit more forthcoming with just a little bit of bottle aging.

91 MURÉ Gewurztraminer Orchidées Sauvages 2020

Steely citrus aromas hint at pineapple and Necco Wafers. The slightly sweet wine has an oily, mouthcoating feel, with a welcome stemmy bitterness that creates a nice balance with the bracing acidity and residual sugar.
