**Riesling 2021 Clos Saint Landelin 92**

This opens up with notes of flint and while the minerally texture adds a tactile first impression. It is finely meshed, medium bodied and it shows flavors of white peach, lemon candy, matchstick and tarragon that echo on the mouth-watering finish.

**Riesling 2021 Côte de Rouffach 91**

A juicy and silky Riesling with bright acidity, this shows an expressive mix of nectarine, guava, roasted pineapple, wet stone, sea salt and bergamot. It is focused, delivering a mouth-watering finish.

**Pinot Gris 2020 Clos Saint Landelin 90**

A spiced, medium-bodied version with a lively and well-balanced profile, featuring a subtle mesh of lentil, blanched almond, melon and stony mineral. Offers a clean finish.

**Pinot Noir 2021 «V» 90**

A juicy, vibrant Pinot with plenty of floral notes and flavors, which underscore the wild cherry, strawberry, and dried herbs. This shows a lovely harmony, while the pure fruit flavors linger on the finish.

**Gewurztraminer 2022 Orchidées Sauvages 89**

Hints of spice, honey and ginger mingle in this subtle, medium-bodied white. Well-cut acidity forms a lively frame for the notes of melon, quince, quinine and candied ginger.
