MURÉ Pinot Noir 2017 «V»

Grand Cru Vorbourg produces some of Alsace's best pinot noir, especially Clos Saint Landelin. The wine is delicate on the nose, with raspberry, blueberry and dried fruit aromas. The palate is voluptuous and concentrated, yet subtle, with beautiful acidity on the finish.
