The top 100 Wines of Alsace

95 MURÉ Pinot Gris Alsace Grand Cru Vorbourg Clos Saint Landelin 2014

A rich and dry Pinot Gris with dried-apple and pineapple character. Hints of walnuts and cedar. Full body, powerful fruit and a flavourful finish. Loads here. Great wine. Made from biodynamically grown grapes. Drink now.

95 MURÉ Crémant d'Alsace Grand Millésime 2011

This Alsace sparkling wine has a stunning lemony freshness, and the sleek body and daringly high acidity are exactly married to the mineral intensity that ends in a stunning, whiplash finish ! Made from biodynamically grown grapes.

93 MURÉ Muscat Alsace Grand Cru Clos Saint Landelin Vendanges Tardives 2014

A dense and sweet white with dried pears, honey and spices. Full body, cooked apricots and a sweet, honey-like finish. Beautiful integration and depth here. Made from biodynamically grown grapes. Drink now.

92 MURÉ Riesling Alsace Grand Cru Clos Saint Landelin Vorbourg 2014

Something subtly earthy shines through all the fruit in this very ripe wine. Quite a tropical nose (maybe some botrytis, certainly some over-ripeness). A rich and powerful dry riesling with a lot of extract and pronounced mineral notes. If only the alcohol wasn't as obvious on the finish this would be much more exciting. Made from biodynamically grown grapes.
