This sleek, light-to medium-bodied white is richly aromatic, with slate and saline notes that expand on the creamy palate.

93 MURÉ Riesling Alsace Côte de Rouffach 2015

A firm, minerally white, with fragrant slate, pine and spice notes leading to poached quince, graphite and almond blossom flavors.
